Let's Celebrate!

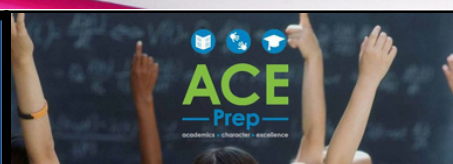
HAPPY NEW YEAR

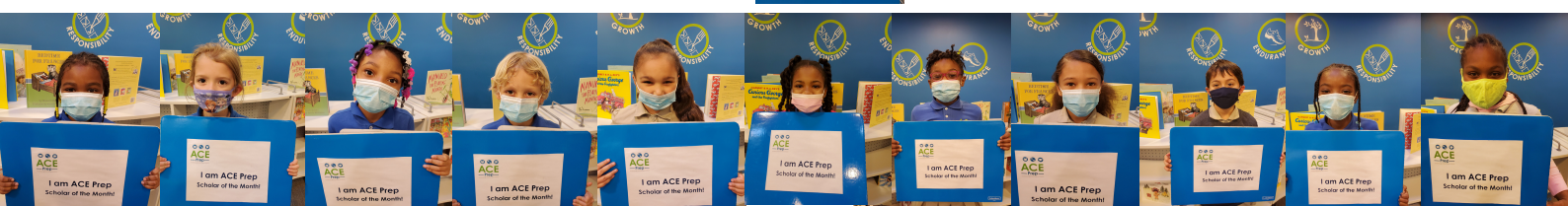

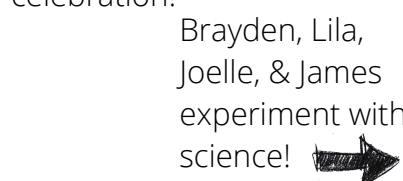

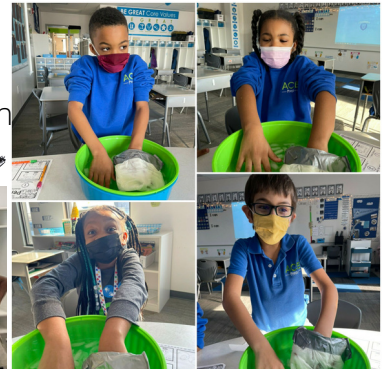
